As Christians, we lead others by our example. Those who would seek areas of responsibility in the church are required to be examples in faith, conduct, and business affairs. To maintain a high standard for workers is one of the best ways to present Christ to the people of our community. Therefore, the following guidelines will be required of any person who works in the Youth Dept. at The Rock Church & World Outreach Center (TRC&WOC).

1. Must have made TRC&WOC your home church, attending regularly for no less than 3 months.
2. Be an active member of TRC&WOC and/or have completed the Serving at the Rock Class.
3. Be able to make at least a minimum six month commitment.
4. Be in unity and agreement with the Pastors and staff of TRC&WOC.
5. Live a separated Christian life, keeping your home life in order, and serve as an example to the teens.
6. Be faithful to attend regular church services, attending at least 1 church service for every 1 service you work in the youth ministry each week.
7. Attend all scheduled Youth Volunteer meetings and trainings.
8. Give at ample notice if you know you will be absent from a scheduled service.
9. Be punctual by arriving 30 minutes before the service begins and staying 10 minutes after it ends.
10. Be neat and modest in your appearance.
11. Give 2 weeks notice when stepping down from youth ministry.
